



PARKER PERFORMANCE AWARD CRITERIA

The following are the conditions for the Annual Parker Performance Award for the most successful exhibitor at any one Show.

- i. Each animal must be bred by the exhibitor.
- ii. There must be three or more exhibitors at the Show.
- iii. There must be two or more exhibitors in each selected class.
- iv. If any exhibitor shows at more than one Show, the points to count are those gained at his best showing.
- v. Points can only be gained at one main or Royal Show in each State. Each Show for any one year is to be nominated by each Regional Group and approved by the National Executive before 31st December for the ensuing year.
- vi. The award is to be determined on four classes for each sex. These four classes are defined as the two most senior, senior classes and the two most senior, junior classes.
- vii. Points shall be awarded as follows: 1st prize, 5 points; 2nd prize, 4 points; 3rd prize, 3 points; Senior Champion award, 2 points; Reserve Senior Champion award, 1 point; Junior Champion award, 2 points; Reserve Junior Champion award, 1 point.
- viii. The award will display the name of the winner and the year date in which the competition points were gained.
